Previously, Aryana served as Senator Mark Warner's Health and Education Legislative Assistant. In this role, she was responsible for legislation development and analysis involving health and education. Aryana also served as Deputy Secretary of Health and Human Resources (HHR) for the Commonwealth of Virginia. As Deputy Secretary, her primary responsibility was to assist the Secretary in directing the HHR agencies. Prior to her appointment in State Government, Aryana worked for the Hospital Corporation of America (HCA). She was in the Chief Operating Officer Development Program at HCA and spent the majority of her time working in hospital operations, outpatient services, and strategic planning.
